INTRODUCTION

Armada Gymnastics Club Inc is committed to working responsibly and ethically within the legal and regulatory environment. To this end all Club policies and procedures will reflect this and we will act and make decisions in accordance with this commitment.

PURPOSE

Armada Gymnastics Club Inc takes great pride in the presentation and representation of the club. The following uniform requirements have been endorsed to ensure all members of our team wear the appropriate attire to participate in activities safely, are easily identified as club members; and represent our club in a positive and professional manner.

DEFINITIONS

Armada Gymnastics Club Inc – AGC.

Members – paid staff, committee members, technical members (judges and coaches) and participants/athletes.

Volunteers – non paid staff, parents working in support roles and any other volunteers assisting the club; and

Visitors- being competing gymnasts from other clubs, spectators and contractors.

POLICY APPLICATION

This policy applies to all members attending Armadale Gymnastics Club's venue; including activities and events held in the club's name or in representing the club at other venues.

POLICY COVERAGE

ALL GYMNASTS/NINJAS

All Gymnasts and Ninjas arriving and leaving the gym, must wear clothing over their leotard /crop top and shorts and must wear shoes at all times.

TINY TOTS, GYMFUN & BEGINNERS

Gymnasts participating in Tiny Tots, Gymfun and Beginner programs are required to wear:

- Comfortable clothing (i.e. T-Shirt and shorts (must be close-fitting or tucked in, no skirts)) or bike pants and crop top or leotard. Underwear to be worn under all options
- Hair tied back neatly
- No socks
- No jewellery except for studs
- No denim

LEVEL, GYMSKILLS AND OPTIONAL CLASS PROGRAMS

Gymnasts participating in Levels & Gymskills programs are required to wear:

GIRLS

Training-

- A Club training leotard is compulsory with optional extras of
 - black bike pants,
 - black leggings,
 - Club crop top
- Underwear to be worn under all options
- No competition leotard to be worn at training
- Hair tied back neatly
- No jewellery should be worn
- No socks

Events and Competitions –

Uniform expectations information for events and Competitions will be given to parents prior to events as per each event/Competition requirement

NINJAS & ADULTS

- Club Polo Shirt or Club T-shirt
- Plain Black shorts or leggings
- No socks
- Hair secured if required
- No jewellery

Events –

Uniform expectations information for events will be given to parents prior to events as per each event requirement

Armadale Gymnastics Club Inc takes pride in our gymnast's club uniform and believe this provides unity & equality amongst our gymnasts. Gymnasts need to wear the correct uniform whilst attending classes unless otherwise specified. Gymnasts out of uniform will be given the following warnings:

- First Offence – the gymnast/ninja will be given a uniform violation notice
- Second Offence – the Gymnast/Ninja being removed from the floor & a parent/guardian called to collect OR bring the correct uniform in for them to change into in order to continue training. There will be no credit for the training missed.

As we do not carry all sizes in stock, if your gymnast has outgrown their training gear or recently moved up levels, exceptions will be made on uniforms while awaiting your order, on the understanding the order has been placed and paid for.

It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to inform the Club if they are in this situation to avoid receiving a first offence notification.
